## Renovations Prompt Temporary Move

Major renovations to the PPS building will require all customer service operations to temporarily move to the empty building across the street, 1515 Broadway, at the end of this month. If all goes as planned, PPS employees will move into the temporary location after the close of business January 25 and start serving customers at 1515 Broadway, Monday, January 28. Anyone needing to conduct any business, in person, with PPS, should go to 1515 Broadway. Parking is available in the rear of that building, and a 24-hour kiosk will be accessible inside. The building is handicap-accessible. While no drive-through service will be available during the renovations, customers may still use the drop-boxes located in the drive-thru lane at 1500 Broadway



and in front of that building. The renovations are prompted by a need to improve security for PPS employees and customers and to better protect customer information. The work is expected to last through April.

## Christmas in the Park Proceeds

Thanks to everyone who supported our 21st annual “Christmas in The Park” fundraiser for area food pantries. The event yielded thousands of dollars and several tons of canned goods for Paducah Cooperative Ministry, Family Service Society, The Salvation Army and St. Vincent DePaul Society. All donations are being counted now, and the final totals will be announced this month.

The contributions for Christmas in the Park come from visitors to the lighting displays at the park, our Stuff the Truck event and the School Challenge. Baptist Health Paducah employees donated 2,790 pounds of canned goods to Stuff the Truck, making them the biggest donor for that event.

In late November and early December, students from fourteen local schools competed for a \$1,000 prize by collecting nonperishable food during the School Challenge. Those schools included: Community Christian Academy Middle/High, Concord



Elementary, Heath Elementary, Heath Middle, Lone Oak Elementary, Lone Oak Intermediate, Lone Oak Middle, McCracken County High, Morgan Elementary, Paducah Middle, Paducah Tilghman, Reidland Elementary, Reidland Middle and St. Mary Middle/High. The winner of the Challenge had not been determined when this newsletter went to print and will be announced this month.
